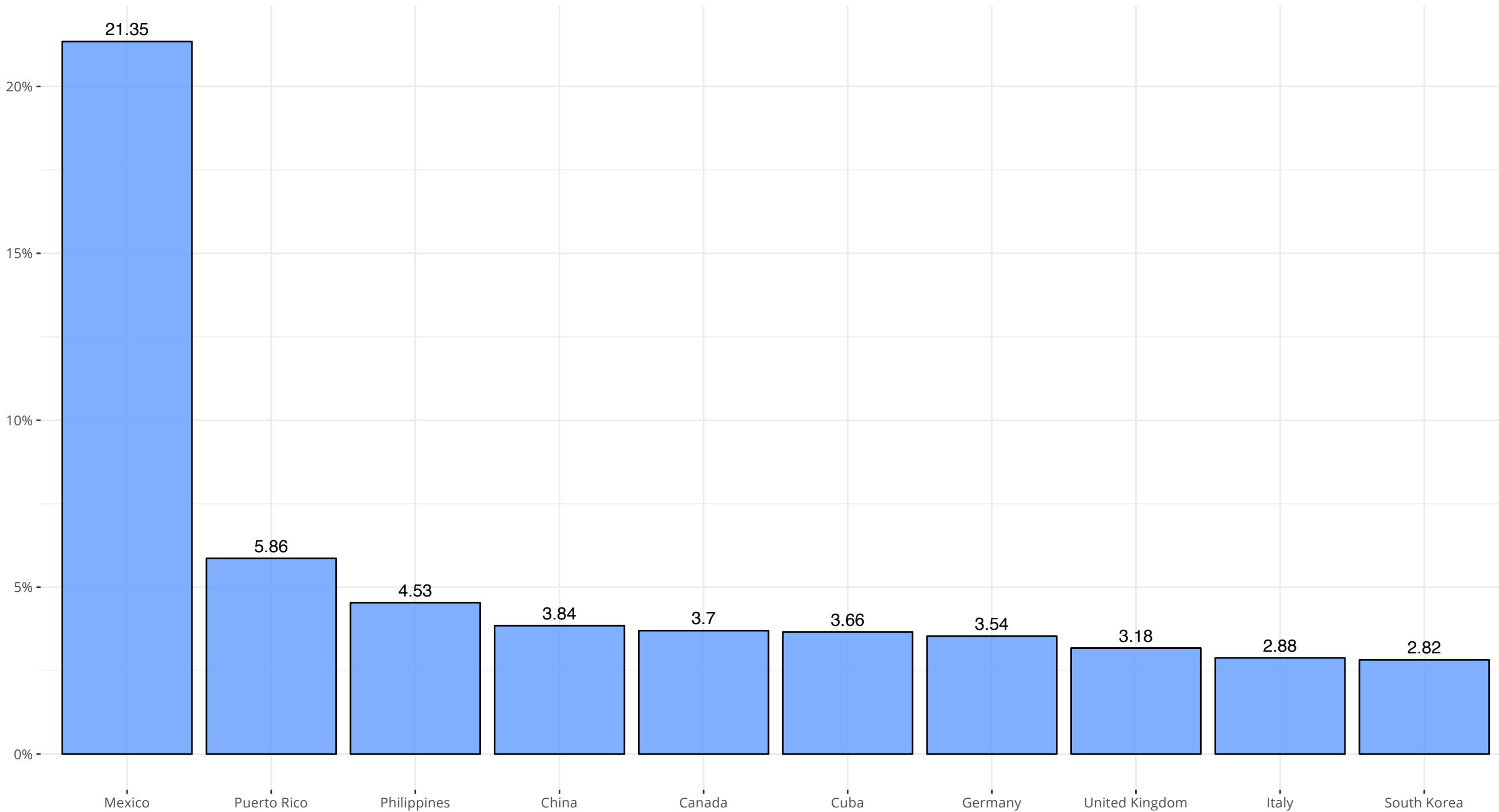


U.S. Migration is Mostly Regional and Mexico Accounts for Just Under a Quarter of It
