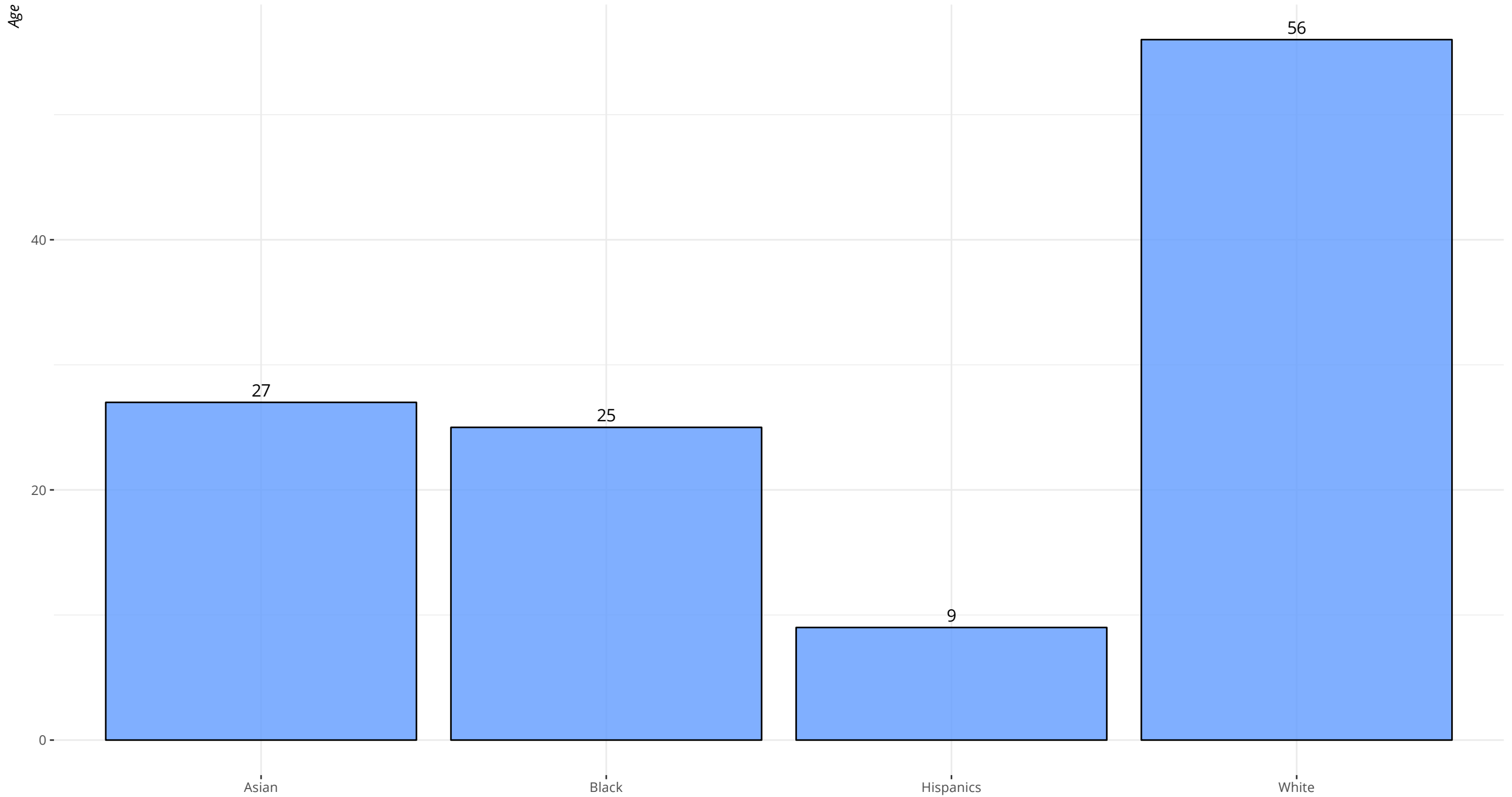


The Modal (i.e. Most Common) Age for a White Person in the U.S. is 56. For Hispanics: 9.
